The goal of this scholarship is to assist graduating seniors who demonstrate the ability to balance and excel in both academic performance and school/community service.

AMOUNT: Four \$1,000 scholarships will be given, maximum of one per high school.

ELIGIBILITY: Must be a graduating senior from Bothell High, Inglemoor High, Woodinville High or Secondary Academy for Success/Northshore Networks. The scholarship must be used at an accredited two or four year university, college or vocational school within the academic year following graduation.

6. What do you think you might like to do once you have completed your post high school education? Why is this of interest? (100 words or less)
7. How has volunteering in your community and/or school affected you and those you have served? Please be specific. Limit your response to 500 words.
8. Does your family have any financial needs that will impact your post high school plans? If yes, please explain.
9. Is there any special information the committee should have when considering your application? If yes, please explain.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS (PROCEDURE)

* Complete the Northshore Council PTSA Scholarship Application.

* Include two letters of recommendation, one of which must be written by a staff member from a community/volunteer service organization. No letters from relatives, please.

* Include a current (should include as much 12th grade detail as possible) copy of your high school transcript.

* Respond to questions outlined above.

* Make sure your application is **postmarked by Friday March 23, 2012**
